



CAMPAIGN RULES

UEAMUN ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Election:

1. Voting will take place both online and at the Annual General Meeting (AGM). Voting online begins on Monday (April 25) and ends at 7pm on Thursday (April 28).
2. The Annual General Meeting will take place on April 28 at 7pm in JSC 1.03, where candidates will be expected to give a speech for why people should vote for them.
3. Only members of the UEA Model UN Society are allowed to vote. One member, one vote. If a member both online and at the AGM, the vote at the AGM supersedes the online vote.
4. Dequorum for the vote is set at 23 (one fourth the membership).
5. Positions will be decided in the following order: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Social Sec, Union Rep. If a candidate wins one position, their nomination will be withdrawn from further positions. If a candidate loses their run, they can nominate themselves for further positions at the AGM.
6. A person is elected through simple majority of votes cast online and those at the AGM.

Campaigns:

7. You can begin campaigning from today (April 23)
8. Campaigns are required to declare the medium of campaigning to the President. Social media like Facebook groups and pages and Twitter are allowed. You can also use your personal Facebook or Twitter page and this does not have to be declared.
9. The current committee will share manifestos via Facebook and email, and will also make a post for each person running.
10. Candidates are allowed to post on the UEAMUN Society page, but the President can suspend this at any time.
11. Negative campaigning is not allowed. Please report any personal attacks, harassment or spamming of any of the candidates. Serious cases of negative campaigning such as racist or homophobic remarks can result in withdrawal of candidacy.
12. Campaigns are not allowed to deliberately misrepresent the candidates or the society.
